Mechanical Engineer trainee

Entry Requirements:

A degree in Mechanical Engineering or a related **Job 1-- Government** subject or a qualification, which satisfies the academic requirements for corporate membership of the Mechanical discipline of the HKIE and for admission into the HKIE Training Scheme 'A' in the Mechanical discipline;

Duties:

Successful candidates will receive practical training under professional guidance meeting the training requirements of the relevant professional institutions. The training period is two years for the above posts.
